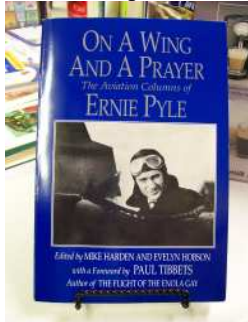
*Basic Field Manual Military Intelligence
